

# Peter Pan – Indians Costume Handout

Welcome to the Indians group! The costume fee for Indians is \$30 and it is due by **April 17**. If it is paid after **April 17**, the costume fee is \$35. All costume fees must be paid at the Information Table during regular rehearsal times. We will not issue your fabric if your costume fee is unpaid.

If you have an Indian costume from a previous MYART Peter Pan, you may be able to use it; however, it cannot be too short or too tight. Please show it to the Costume Committee for approval.

You are responsible for constructing your own costume, using materials provided by MYART. We will provide the fabric, and some trim pieces. You will cut out your fabric and bring it to rehearsal on **March 20** for the Painting Party. There MYART will provide paint and stamps to decorate the fabric so you can create a unique look for your Indian.

The costume itself is not difficult to sew, and the following patterns are pre-approved:

Simplicity 5448 (child sizes), 5446 (adults), Butterick 4171 (child and adult sizes)  
McCall's 2851 (child sizes), 6799 (adults)

You may use other patterns, but please let us approve them before you cut your fabric. The costumes can be embellished with beads and feathers and fringe if you would like (NO SEQUINS OR SHINY TRIM). Approved colors for embellishments are: purple, burgundy, brown, grey, ochre, rust, white

Indians should wear moccasins, without socks. A good source for moccasins on the internet is: <http://www.minnetonka-by-mail.com> or you can make them from a kit which you may find at Michaels or on the internet.

Indians in Specialty Dance should wear tan colored half-soles which are available at Dance Threadz, or on the internet at sites like <http://www.discountdance.com>.

If you do not sew but want to learn, we can help you get started during rehearsal times on Saturday. The costume is fairly simple for a beginner, and can be a fun creative opportunity. If you truly cannot sew, MYART can arrange to construct your costume for you for an additional \$40 fee. This fee must be paid on or before March 20.

If you would like to volunteer to sew for others, you can make an Indian costume to satisfy your fundraising requirement. Please let the Costume Committee (Mary) know if you are interested.

**Costume check for Indians is April 17**, during regular Group Rehearsal times. Please wear your complete costume to this rehearsal.
