

Peter Pan – Pirate Costume Handout ARG!

Pirates – Costume Fee is \$10 and is due on or before April 17. Late costume fee will be \$15. Pay the costume fee at the information table. Costume pieces will not be distributed until the costume fee is paid.

You are assigned to the Pirate Group and will be constructing your own pirate costume for this role, embellished by a colorful headscarf and sash provided by MYART. Please note that **ALL PIRATES ARE MEN**. Your costume should be assembled from bright, colorful pieces and will have the following elements:

Shirt – Either a striped, long sleeved tee shirt, or a “pirate shirt” with long, full flowing sleeves.

Vest – Optional in contrasting color to shirt

Pants – Either pants or pantaloons worn below the knee (cropped pants so we can see your socks). No solid black pants,

Socks – To the knee, stripes are desirable

Shoes – Black shoes, jazz shoes, jazz boots or black boots, no athletic-type shoes or jazz shoes.

Extras – Gold chains, hoop earrings, eye patches, parrots. Pirates “wear their wealth”

Headscarf & sash – Provided by MYART, mandatory on stage.

The pirates are bright and boisterous and masculine. All hair must be tied back and covered by the headscarf.

Your costume should have several contrasting colors, stripes and patterns suitable to a pirate are fine. All deep bright colors may be used except **red, which is reserved for Hook and Smee**. Think purple, royal blue, orange, gold, yellow, turquoise, fuchsia, lime or bright green (NO RED).

You will be able to find most of your costume pieces at Thrift stores, or if you have the gift of sewing, you can have fun making your own. These patterns are suitable: Simplicity 4923, McCall’s 4952 and Butterick 4574. The costume committee will be happy to help beginners during regular Saturday rehearsals. If this is your first sewing project, start early!

Costume Check for Pirates will be March 27 during regular group rehearsal. Wear your costume to rehearsal and you will be issued your headscarf and sash at that time. Headscarves and sashes cannot be issued until the costume fee is paid.
